

In order to ensure order, public order, and the safety of people and property at the public event **EVROPSKA RAZSTAVA PSOV EDS 2024** held at Celjski sejem d.d., Dečkova 1, 3102 Celje, from 03.10.2024 till 06.10.2024, each day from 05.30 till 20.00 hrs, organizer **Kínološka zveza Slovenije**, Zapoge 3D, Vodice and the person responsible Hari Arčon hereby

PUBLIC EVENT RULES AND REGULATIONS (HOUSE RULES)

GENERAL PROVISIONS

The house rules govern the manner of using the event space, the system of entry, movement, and behavior, and prohibitions for the duration and in the area of the public event, namely:

- Participants are obliged to respect and follow the house rules.
- Participants are obliged to inform the organizer or other person responsible of any irregularities or injuries noticed or sustained during the public event.
- In the event of a violation of order or public order, the person involved must leave the secure area immediately if requested to do so by persons responsible.
- Participants may only use the public event spaces and areas designated by the organizer, manager, or other person responsible.
- The number of participants in the public event space area may not exceed the number laid down in the operating permit, capacity, fire regulations, or other rules.
- The organizer is not responsible for items left unsupervised in concerts area or other event spaces.
- The event area is in some parts are technically secured with a video surveillance system.
- Some special areas may only be accessed with accreditation issued by the organizer.

SPECIAL RULES

- **With the help of the security service or safety stewards, the organizer carries out access control during the public event (identity checks, surface checks of outer garments and luggage, other checks) and on all area of public event.**
- **During the public event, visitors are strictly prohibited from climbing and jumping over security fences and entering special areas without proper accreditation.**
- **Visitors under 16 years of age are allowed to enter only when accompanied by parents, foster parents or legal guardian.**
- **Only registered animals and service dogs are allowed to enter the event area.**
- **Accredited photographers, journalists and exhibitors are allowed to use photographic equipment.**
- **Exhibitors can only use the parking space they have paid for.**
- **Visitors are PROHIBITED from bringing in and using professional cameras.**

PROHIBITIONS:

- Any expressions of racial, religious, national, sexual, political, and other intolerance and violent or insulting behavior towards employees, security personnel, the organizers, persons responsible, and other visitors are STRICTLY prohibited in the public event area.
- Any drunk or otherwise intoxicated persons and persons who may or have already violated the order or public order in the (secure) area are prohibited from entering.
- It is prohibited to carry weapons, explosive substances, and other hazardous substances and items.
- The use of pyrotechnics is prohibited.
- In the official parking lots and other parts of the secure area where the organizer is responsible for order, visitors are prohibited for playing music.
- It is prohibited to cause damage to the equipment, inventory, and other property.
- The placing of advertising signs is permitted solely subject to a prior arrangement with the owner, renter, or organizer of a public event.
- It is prohibited to move the equipment, inventory, and devices within the event area.
- In the secure area it is prohibited to install any equipment or objects without prior permission from the organizer.
- It is prohibited to park vehicles or place any objects in front of the entrances/exits.

EVENTS

- In accordance with the legislation, the organizer has declared the event with the competent authorities.
- The **secure area** includes the concert area, camp, buildings, and their immediate surroundings or the areas and parking lots necessary for the organization of the public event, which the organizer has at its disposal and where it maintains order during the event.
- Maintaining order and public order at the event is the responsibility of the organizer, the security service, and/or the safety steward service.
- If a ticket is required for admission, the tickets will be marked accordingly. The visitor shows bracelet at the entrance and passes through access control.

The **safety steward service** will act in accordance with the Public Gathering Act and other legislation.

The **security service** will act in accordance with the Private Security Act and other legislation. The security personnel are dressed and marked in accordance with the Private Security Act (ZZasV-1) and the Public Gathering Act. The safety stewards are marked in accordance with the Public Gathering Act.

In case of an incident:

- The event organizer is obliged with the help of the security services and in emergencies with the help of the police to carry out the necessary measures to ensure the safety of people and property.

By the end of the public event or in accordance with the permit or operating hours, the organizer is obliged with the help of the event manager or the head of security and the use of security service measures:

- Before the end of the event to start carrying out measures to clear the event area in order to ensure the uninterrupted and safe exit (dispersal) of participants; and
- To check all spaces and areas used during the event.

MEASURES IN THE EVENT OF VIOLATIONS

In the event of violations of the house rules or public order, the following measures may be introduced against the violator(s):

- Warning, spoken order.
- Secure area entry ban.
- Identity check.
- Exclusion of the person from the secure area.
- Temporary confiscation of items.
- Detainment until the arrival of the police.
- Other measures in accordance with the legislation.
- The security personnel are entitled to record the procedures where security measures might be used (especially the use of physical force and detainment).

HOUSE RULES ENFORCEMENT CONTROL

The house rules enforcement control is carried out by the organizer, safety stewards, security personnel, or other persons authorized by the organizer.

FINAL PROVISIONS

Any found or confiscated items will be kept by the organizer in the service rooms where visitors can pick them up during operating hours or after the end of the public event.

Any visitors in possession of prohibited items will be handed over to the competent authorities in accordance with the legislation.

Visitors will be held criminally and materially liable in the event of intentional damage caused to equipment, devices, or other property.

Visitors will be obliged to compensate or repair the damage caused. If they refuse to do so, they will be required to cover the damage upon the finality of formal proceedings lodged with the competent authorities by the organizer or other person responsible.

The organizer will not be liable for any damage caused by the confiscation of objects or items from visitors in the secure area of the public event.

Visitors use the spaces, devices, and surfaces in the secure area at their own risk.

The organizer is obliged to display the house rules in a visible place outside the entrance to the public event and, if necessary, inform the visitors of the house rules via the Public Address system.

In accordance with Article 11, Item 9 of the Private Security Act and by agreement with the client, the security service will hang SECURITY signs in visible places, as well as multiple signs with the most important instructions (extract) from the house rules in the secure area.

The house rules must be signed by the person responsible and enter into force on the date of adoption.
