



OFFICIAL NOTIFICATION REGARDING THE PARTICIPATION OF PHOTOGRAPHERS AND JOURNALISTS AT EDS 2024

Dear photographers and journalists,

The Cynological Association of Slovenia and the Organizing Committee of the EDS 2024 would like to address the incorrect information that has been circulating publicly.

The organizing committee of EDS 2024 does not impose any restrictions on attendance to this exceptional event in Celje, Slovenia. However, all journalists and photographers are required to adhere to the conditions stated on the website to attend the event. We would also like to clarify that there is no official photographer designated for the event, and therefore everyone is afforded the same opportunities.

We fully support all journalists and media houses as they are promoters of the extraordinary sport and true ambassadors of the European FCI Dog Show 2024 in Celje, Slovenia. Since the accreditation publication, it has been made clear that journalists reporting on the exhibition through media houses can do so free of charge with the appropriate application form. We will do our best to ensure they feel valued and that their work complies with the journalistic code. Free parking, free entry, and a special area for journalists at the event itself will be guaranteed for them.

The €450 + VAT fee only applies to photographers who are there to sell pictures. We must address the issue of illegal photography without proper registration and documentation, which is unacceptable. As organizers, we have the legal right to charge for this type of photography. Every photographer who obtains accreditation has the right to take pictures in competition rings and the BIS program. In this way, photography is not limited even for sales purposes.

We believe this policy is fair and necessary to uphold the standards of our event.
